XII INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON ANTARCTIC EARTH SCIENCE ISAES 2015 13-17 July 2015, GOA, INDIA



The International symposium on Antarctic Earth Sciences (ISAES) is a SCAR-initiative aimed at showcasing Antarctic geoscience research, taking stock of the accomplishments of the International fraternity and providing guidance for future studies. The First ISAES was organised way back in 1963 at Cape Town, and the last one (11th) at Edinburgh, with the Symposium traversing through Oslo, Madison, Adelaide, Cambridge, Tokyo, Siena, Wellington, Potsdam and Santa Barbara. In its 50-year history, Japan has been the only Asian country to hold it with India being bestowed the honor to host it in 2015.

We look forward to welcoming you to Goa in July 2015!!

The Symposium is scheduled to be hosted by the Earth System Science Organization (ESSO) of the Ministry of Earth Sciences, and its R&D Wing, the National Centre for Antarctic and Ocean Research (NCAOR), in Goa, the most sought-after tourist destination in India (<http://www.goatourism.gov.in>)

Some of the proposed science themes for the Symposium are the following. Suggestions on other relevant topics are also most welcome:

- Transition from persistent to dynamic ice sheet-evidence from ocean sediments
- Comparative evolution of WAIS and EAIS during Neogene
- Suturing of east and west Gondwana - geophysical and geological data
- Cryosphere evolution in Antarctica and Himalaya during Plio-Pleistocene- Global versus Regional forcings
- Connections between the southern continents-nature of east Antarctic crust versus others
- Flight of continents and vertebrate evolution
- LIPs in Gondwanaland
- Antarctica and global energy concerns
- Southern ocean processes including sedimentological processes, deglaciation, sea level fluctuations, climate, paleoclimate, paleoceanography
