3. Candidate must bring following in **original** and **01 each self attested photocopy** for verification: -

- At least one identity proof having photo [e.g. Aadhaar card, Employer ID, Passport, PAN card, Voter ID, etc.
- 01 passport size colour photograph
- Proof of Date of Birth
- Caste certificate (if applicable)
- Mark sheets and passing certificates for all educational / professional qualifications and relevant experience. Experience proof must indicate dates and duration of experience gained.
- No Objection Certificate from employer (if working in Government / Public Sector Undertakings / Autonomous bodies).

4. **No request for change in the date and venue of the written examination will be entertained.**

5. Use Blue/Black Ball Point Pen only is permitted.

6. Calculators and Mobile phones or any other electronic device are strictly **NOT** permitted in the Test Hall.

7. No travelling advance will be paid for attending the interview/written examination except Out-station SC/ST candidates, who will be paid to-and-fro Sleeper-class railway/Bus fare by the shortest route on production of proof of journey tickets etc.

8. Please note that the candidature of all the applicants is purely provisional in nature and is subject to thorough verification of the credentials such as qualification, experience, age, category, physical disability etc.

Paper-II (Conventional Type)	Descriptive	Translation & Essay	The paper will contain two passages for translation-one passage for translation from Hindi to English and one passage for translation from English to Hindi, and an Essay each in Hindi and English, to test the candidates, translation skills and their ability to write as well as comprehend the two languages correctly, precisely and effectively. The level of the paper will be consistent with the educational qualifications prescribed.	04 (Two Passage and Two essay)	100	02 Hrs

Note:- There will be negative marking of 0.33 marks for objective type questions.

(i) Paper-I will consist of Objective Type- Multiple choice questions only.

(ii) The candidate scoring the highest marks in the examination shall be selected. However, the candidate has to score **minimum of 25% marks in Paper I and atleast 35% marks in Paper II.**
