# A. QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE:-

**For Ex-Indian Army personnel** :- minimum four years experience in respective trades **For civilians**: ITI Certification in relevant trade with four years experience or Diploma in Engineering in relevant field with two years working experience.

## • <u>Sr. No. 9:</u>

Diploma in General Nursing or Bachelor of Science in Nursing as approved by Indian Nursing Council or Diploma in Operation Technique or Certificate in relevant subject from an Institute recognized by the Central or the State Government with four years experience.

## • <u>Sr. No. 10:</u>

Degree/Diploma in Hotel Management and Catering Technology or Culinary Art from a recognized Indian University/Institute with two Years of experience in a registered firm/airlines/hotel/food chain.

## B. <u>Terms of Employment</u>:

1). The initial period of contract shall be for a period of 5 months or 14 months starting from October/November, 2014 depending upon the need and suitability of the candidates. Based on the requirement, the contract can also be extended by few months.

4). The selected candidates depending on whether for short term or long term shall be entitled for special kit allowance of Rs. 20000/- (short term) and Rs. 30000/- (long term) subject to production of original vouchers.

5). Group Personal Accident Insurance Coverage upto 25 Lakhs for the selected candidates will be provided by NCAOR for the expedition period

6). The short listed candidates will have to undergo Medical Examination at All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi and Pre-Antarctic Snow Ice Acclimatisation training at ITBP, Auli (near Joshimath, Garhwal, Himalayas) for about 15 days. The dates will be informed by NCAOR later.

7). On final selection the candidates will be required to sign a contract with NCAOR.

8). The selected candidates will participate in the Antarctic expedition as team members and will have to perform all the routine duties and jobs related to expedition as assigned by the Leader of Expedition from time to time.
